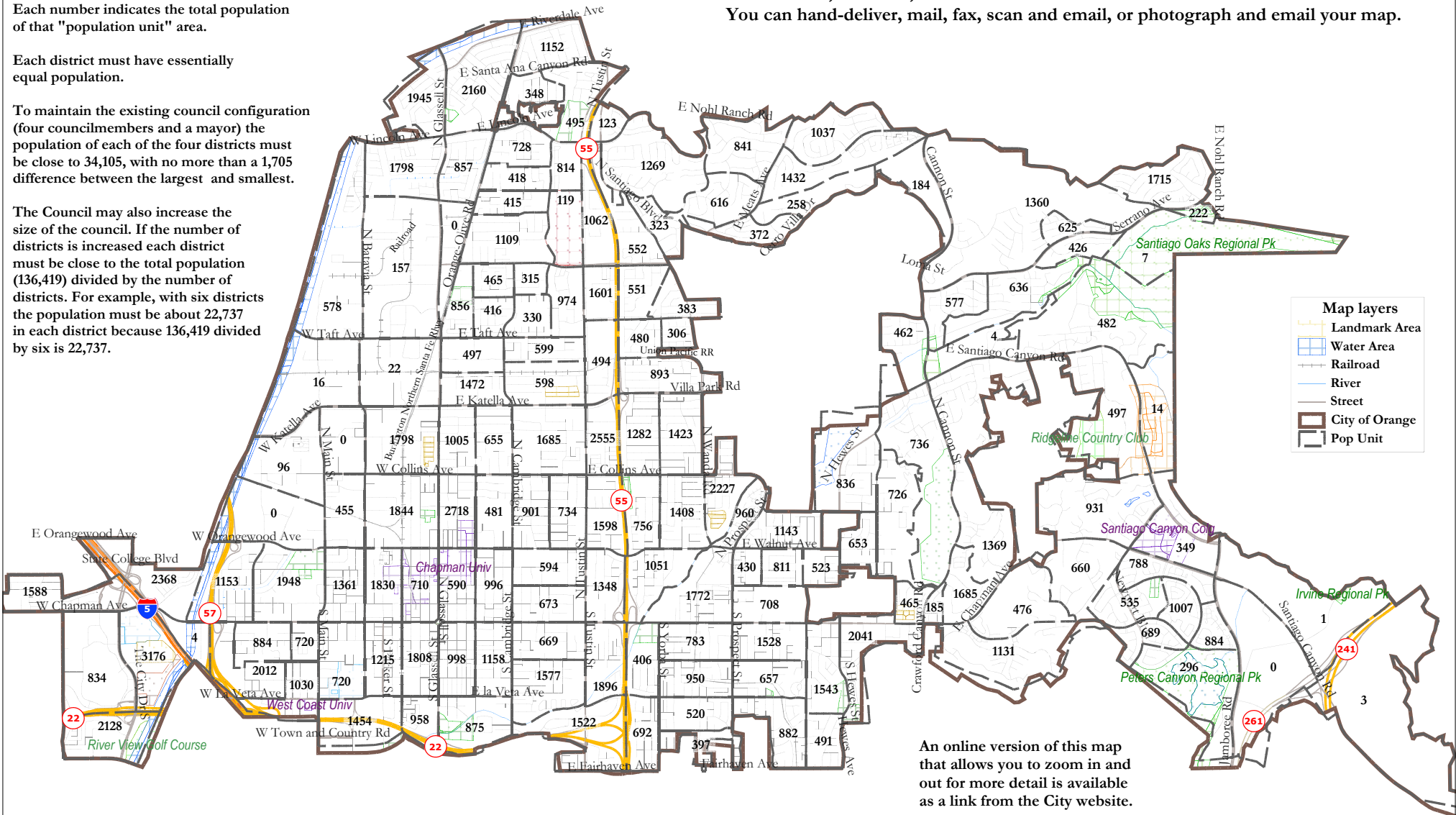
You can hand-deliver, mail, fax, scan and email, or photograph and email your map.

Each number indicates the total population of that "population unit" area.

Each district must have essentially equal population.

To maintain the existing council configuration (four councilmembers and a mayor) the population of each of the four districts must be close to 34,105, with no more than a 1,705 difference between the largest and smallest.

The Council may also increase the size of the council. If the number of districts is increased each district must be close to the total population (136,419) divided by the number of districts. For example, with six districts the population must be about 22,737 in each district because 136,419 divided by six is 22,737.
